Dear Residents,

We have no new cases of COVID-19 in staff or residents since our last report to you. However, I'm deeply saddened to report that one of our Skilled Nursing residents who has been in the hospital due to complications from COVID-19 passed away on Saturday. We grieve for this tragic loss. We have also been notified that one resident who has been in the hospital is transferring to another hospital and is not expected to return to Penrose Harbor. This person will be taken off of our reporting list after today. At this time, we no longer have any Penrose Harbor hospitalized residents.

I do have encouraging news to report today. One resident in Skilled Nursing is now considered recovered from COVID-19 and is doing well. Four other residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 are not showing any symptoms as of the time of this message and are doing well.

We will be conducting our staff and resident testing tomorrow as directed by the Tacoma-Pierce County Public Health Department. We will be testing all residents of Penrose Harbor, all staff of Penrose Harbor, and all staff of Heron's Key who have frequent interaction with Independent Living residents.
