Dear Residents,

I am pleased to share we are continuing our pattern of no new cases of COVID-19 and gradual recovery of both staff and residents. Today I can report 2 more Skilled Nursing residents who are now recovered and we expect our remaining staff members to be able to return next week at the conclusion of their quarantine period. We have one resident who remains in serious condition.

Our current numbers as of today are:

- **Residents currently residing within Independent Living**
total: 0 (no change) | with symptoms: 0 | without symptoms at this time: 0
| recovered and removed from list: 2 (no change)
- **Residents currently residing within Penrose Harbor Skilled Nursing**
total: 8 (down 2 from yesterday) | with symptoms: 5 | without symptoms at this time: 5
| recovered and removed from list: 8 (up 2 from yesterday)
- **Penrose Harbor staff recovering at home**
total: 4 (no change) | with symptoms: 4 | without symptoms at this time: 0
| recovered and removed from list: 11 (no change)
- **Total transfers of COVID-19 positive residents**
 - Penrose Harbor transfer to hospital*: 0 (no change)
 - Residents originally residing in Independent Living admitted to Skilled Nursing: 1 (no change)

- **COVID-19-positive residents who have passed away: 2 (no change)**

We conduct our weekly testing on Tuesdays so this will allow us to give you up-to-date reporting on test results.
